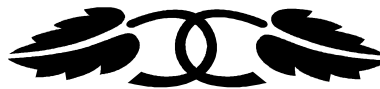

Types of Proposals

PAPER: Paper sessions provide an opportunity to present research and/or practice focused on the conference theme.

POSTER SESSION: Posters offer the opportunity to present a topic in display form rather than as a formal oral presentation.

ROUNDTABLE: Roundtable sessions offer opportunities to obtain insights and suggestions from colleagues in an informal, interactive format.

All proposals are welcome and must be submitted electronically.

For each proposal submitted electronically, authors must submit the following documents in Microsoft Word:

- A summary sheet containing (1) the name of a school/college affiliation, preferred address, preferred telephone number and e-mail address of each author; (2) format appropriate for the presentation (paper session, roundtable, or poster session); (3) conference strand on which the proposal is focused; and (4) the presentation title and a 50-word summary of the presentation suitable for inclusion in the Conference program.
- An anonymous, clearly titled abstract of no more than 250 words for blind review.

The deadline for submitting proposals is extended to Friday, September 21, 2012.

Authors with proposals accepted for presentation will be notified on or about Friday, September 28, 2012.

All presenters must be paid registrants of the fall conference.
